

This Program Planner is for BJ students commencing in Semester 2, 2023

Program Guidelines

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a **program** and a subject as a **course**.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your plan (Extended Major or Minor or one of your two Majors).

The BJ structure

The program comprises three components:

- 24 units for all BJ Core Courses, and
- 8 units for BJ Flexible Core Courses, and
- 16 units for BJ Elective Courses

You will complete all 24 units of BJ Core Courses and 8 units of BJ Flexible Core Courses. You will also complete 16 units for BJ Elective Course which can comprise:

- General Electives from the BJ course list or from other undergraduate course lists; or
- One BJ minor (8 units) and 8 units of General Electives, or
- Two BJ minors (8 units each).

How to use this planner

This document assists you to draft an enrolment plan to complete the Bachelor of Journalism.

Core courses that must be taken in sequence are pre-filled. Read the program rules below, then add the courses that you are required to complete for your elective component. You will find your plan and course requirements on the Programs and Courses [website](#). Don't forget to save the document to your files.
