

## This Program Planner is for BSocSc students commencing in Semester 2, 2023

#### **Program Guidelines**

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a program and a subject as a course.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your plan (Majors).

#### The BSocSc structure

The program comprises 48 units over three components:

- BSocSc Core courses (16 units)
- One BSocSc Major (16 units)
- BSocSc Elective Courses (16 units)

You will complete a minimum of one BSocSc Major (16 units). You will also complete 16 units for BSocSc Elective Courses which can comprise:

- General Electives from the BSocSc course list or from other undergraduate course lists; or
- Second BSocSc Major.

#### How to use this planner

This document assists you to draft an enrolment plan to complete the Bachelor of Social Science.

Core courses that must be taken in sequence are pre-filled. Read the program rules below, then add the courses that you are required to complete for your majors. You will find your plan and course requirements on the Programs and Courses <u>website</u>. Don't forget to save the document to your files.

#### **Program Rules**

#### 1. Progression through program

You must complete your first 4 units from courses in the BSocSc Core Courses or BSocSc Majors sections.

#### 2. Course selection

- Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1.
- Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.

#### 3. Cross-Listed courses

As a course can only be credited once, the following course replacements are approved in circumstances in which a course is listed in more than one plan (minor or major).

- a. Where a course is compulsory in one plan
  - The course must be counted towards the plan in which it is compulsory. A replacement course, at the same level or higher, must then be selected from the other nominated plan.
- b. Where a course is compulsory in more than one plan
  - A replacement course from the other nominated plan at the same level or higher may be selected.
