MAppLing structure

Students in the 1 year duration complete 16 units from the following:

- 8 units Core Courses, and
 - Either
 - Field of Study Option (8 units), or
 - No Field of Study Option (8 units).

Field of Study Option

Students who choose the Field of Study Option complete a Field of Study (8 units) in either *TESOL Studies* or *Language and Discourse Analysis*.

No Field of Study Option

Students who choose the No Field of Study Option complete 8 units from MAppLing Program Elective Courses.

How to use this planner

This document assists you to draft an enrolment plan to complete the Master of Applied Linguistics (1 year duration).

Core courses that must be taken in sequence are pre-filled. Read the program rules below, then add the courses that are required to complete the option you choose. Program Rules

1. Course selection

Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 7.

Selected courses must include at least 12 units at level 6 or higher.

Selected courses must include at most 4 units at level 4.

2. No credit for Foundational Courses

No credit will be given for SLAT7001, SLAT7705, SLAT7706, WRIT6001 or PHIL7111.

3. Exit award

Award of the Graduate Certificate in Applied Linguistics

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 8 units may apply and be awarded the Graduate Certificate in Applied Linguistics.
