

This Program Planner is for BCCJ students commencing in Semester 2, 2023

Program Guidelines

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a **program** and a subject as a **course**.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program.

The BCCJ structure

The program comprises 48 units over three components:

- BCCJ Core courses (28 units)
- BCCJ Flexible Core courses (4 units)
- BCCJ Elective Courses (16 units)

You will complete 16 units for BCCJ Elective Courses which can comprise:

- BCCJ Recommended General Electives; or
- General Electives from the BCCJ course list or from other undergraduate course lists.

How to use this planner

This document assists you to draft an enrolment plan to complete the Bachelor of Criminology and Criminal Justice.

Core courses that must be taken in sequence are pre-filled. Read the program rules below, then add the courses that you are required to complete for your majors.
