### MDevPract structure

The program consists of 24 units for one of the following:

- 16 units for all MDevPract Core Courses, and
- 8 units for MDevPract Research and Program Elective Courses

MDevPract Core Courses and MDevPract Research Courses that must be taken in sequence are pre-filled. Read the program rules below, then add the MDevPract Elective Courses that you choose to complete from the approved list. ### Course Scheduling

## Program Rules

### 1. Course selection

Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 7.

Selected courses must include at least 12 units at level 6 or higher.

Selected courses must include at most 6 units at level 3.

### 2. Progression Through the Program Suite

The Graduate Certificate in Community Development is taken to be part of the Development Practice suite of programs.

### 3. Exit award

#### Award of the Graduate Diploma in Development Practice

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 16 units may apply and be awarded the Graduate Diploma in Development Practice.
