

# This Program Planner is for Bachelor of Arts (BA) students starting in 2024

# **Important Information**

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a program and a subject as a course.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program (Extended Major or Minor or one of your two Majors or General Electives).

# **BA Program Requirements**

Your BA comprises 48 units that you will complete over three years.

- Complete 32 units comprising -
  - Option 1 Two BA Majors (16 units each); OR
  - Option 2 One BA Extended Major (24 units) and one BA Minor (8 units); AND
- Complete 16 units from BA Elective Courses comprising -
  - BA Program Electives and General Electives; OR
  - All General Elective Courses; OR
  - o One BA Major; OR
  - o One BA Minor and General Elective Courses; OR
  - o Two BA Minors

*General Elective Courses* are courses that can be from other areas in the BA or from other undergraduate programs that do not have restrictions.

## Additional Rules

The BA program has an Additional Rule that a student must complete their **first 8 units of courses** from the **BA Courses** and/or **BA Program Elective Courses** list/s. BA Program Electives comprise only of MATH1040 and PHSS2000. Accordingly, you will not be able to complete General Electives in your first full-time semester and all of your first 8 units/four courses must be from the BA Courses and/or BA Program Electives. From your second semester onwards you may select General Elective Courses from other undergraduate course lists.

# Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a Minor (8 units), Major (16 units), or Extended Major (24 units). In the BA you will need to select either Two BA Majors or one BA Extended Major and one BA Minor.

Ensure the plans for your BA are correctly listed in your <u>mySI-net</u> account. If you require assistance selecting your plans, follow these <u>instructions</u>.

## Overseas Exchange

# How to use this Program Planner

This Program Planner assists you in drafting an enrolment plan to complete the requirements of a Bachelor of Arts as a full-time student over three years.

If you are an **international student** with a credit arrangement from one of our partnering institutions, we have tailored <u>study plans</u> to assist you in completing your program requirements at UQ.

## Course Scheduling

This program planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses in 2024. Students should note that course scheduling can change from year to year. You are advised to check the scheduling for the current year and contact the <u>Faculty</u> for advice if course scheduling has changed.

# **Bachelor of Arts – Additional Rules**

## 1. Progression through program

- A student must complete their first 8 units from courses listed in BA Courses and/or BA Program Elective Courses.
- A student can complete a maximum of 32 units of courses with the same discipline descriptor. These are the four alpha characters at the beginning of the course code, for example, POLS or PSYC or MUSC.

## 2. Course selection

- Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1.
- Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.
- No more than 32 units may be completed from courses with the same discipline descriptor (for example POLS or PSYC).

## 3. Restricted plan combinations

- The BA Major in Chinese or BA Minor in Chinese can NOT be undertaken with the BA Major in Chinese Translation and Interpreting or BA Minor in Chinese Translation and Interpreting.
- The BA Major in French or BA Minor in French can NOT be undertaken with the BA Major in French Advanced or BA Minor in French Advanced.
- The BA Major in Japanese or BA Minor in Japanese can NOT be undertaken with the BA Extended Major in Japanese Advanced, BA Major in Japanese Advanced, or BA Minor in Japanese Advanced.



#### 4. Cross-Listed Courses

- As a course can only be credited once, the following course replacement rules apply where a course is listed in more than one of your selected plans (minor, major or extended major).
  - If the course is compulsory in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only. You
    must replace the compulsory course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second
    plan, at the same level or higher.
  - If the course is compulsory in one plan only, it will be credited towards the plan in which it is compulsory. You must select the alternative course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second plan, at the same level or higher.
  - o If the course is an elective in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only.
