

This Program Planner is for Bachelor of International Studies (BIntSt) students starting in 2024

Important Information

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a program and a subject as a course.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program (Core Courses, Flexible Core Courses, your two Majors or General Electives).

BIntSt Program Requirements

Your BIntSt comprises 48 units that you will complete over three years.

- o 6 units for all BIntSt Core Courses; AND
- 4 units from BIntSt Flexible Core Courses; AND
- 6 units from General Elective Courses*; AND
- One BIntSt Language Major (16 units); AND
- One BIntSt International Studies Major (16 units)

*You'll complement these studies with a compulsory overseas exchange semester, during which we recommend you complete your 6 units of General Elective courses.

General Elective Courses are courses that can be from other areas in the BIntSt course list or from other undergraduate programs that do not have restrictions.

Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being a Major (16 units). In the BIntSt you will need to select one Language Major and one International Studies Major.

Ensure the plans for your BIntSt are correctly listed in your <u>mySI-net</u> account. If you require assistance selecting your plans, follow these instructions.

Compulsory Overseas Exchange Semester

You will need to apply for your Compulsory Semester-based Exchange which is recommended to be completed in Semester 1 Year 3. Applications for exchange in Semester 1, Year 3 will need to be lodged in May 31 Year 2. Bachelor of International Studies - Additional Rules

- Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1.
- Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.

1. Hurdle Requirements

This program requires students to complete the following hurdle requirements:

• Students must successfully complete at least 6 units in courses approved by the executive dean for studies undertaken on overseas exchange.

2. Exit Awards

· Award of the Bachelor of Arts

A student who withdraws from the program after completing the requirements for the Bachelor of Arts program may apply and be awarded the Bachelor of Arts.

3. Cross-Listed Courses

- As a course can only be credited once, the following course replacement rules apply where a course is
 listed in more than one of your selected plans (minor, major or extended major).
 - o If the course is compulsory in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only. You must replace the compulsory course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second plan, at the same level or higher.
 - If the course is compulsory in one plan only, it will be credited towards the plan in which it is compulsory. You must select the alternative course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second plan, at the same level or higher.
 - o If the course is an elective in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only.

³ Please note that students may need to take the equivalent of one level 3 course (or Level 2 course if they go on exchange in Year 2) during their exchange semester. It is recommended that students complete compulsory Level 2 and Level 3 courses at UQ

⁴ COMU3060 commences in semester 1 (Part A) with an online component however the majority of the course will be completed in semester 2 (Part B). Students who go on exchange in Year 2, Semester 2, will enrol in COMU3065 across Year 2, Semester 2 (Part A) and Year 3, Semester 1 (Part B). In this case students will need to enrol in a level 2 or 3 course from their Language Major or International Studies Major in their exchange semester.
