This Program Planner is for Bachelor of Journalism (BJ) students starting in 2024

Important Information

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a program and a subject as a course.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program (Extended Major or Minor or one of your two Majors or General Electives).

BJ Program Requirements

Your BJ comprises 48 units that you will complete over three years.

- 24 units for all BJ Core Courses, and
- 8 units for BJ Flexible Core Courses, and
- 16 units for BJ Elective Courses.

You will complete all 24 units of BJ Core Courses and 8 units of BJ Flexible Core Courses. You will also complete 16 units for BJ Elective Courses which can comprise:

- General Electives from the BJ course list or from other undergraduate course lists; or
- · One BJ minor (8 units) and 8 units of General Electives, or
- Two BJ minors (8 units each).

General Elective Courses are courses that can be from other areas in the BJ or from other undergraduate programs that do not have restrictions.

Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a Minor (8 units), Major (16 units), or Extended Major (24 units). In the BJ you may select either One or Two BJ Minors to complete as part of the 'BJ Elective Courses' section.

Ensure the plans for your BJ are correctly listed in your <u>mySI-net</u> account. If you require assistance selecting your plans, follow these instructions.

How to use this Program Planner

This Program Planner assists you in drafting an enrolment plan to complete the requirements of a Bachelor of Journalism as a full-time student over three years.

Read the program rules below, then add the courses that you are required to complete for your BJ Elective Courses. You can view the list of courses available on the <u>BJ Program Requirements</u> Programs and Courses website.

Bachelor of Journalism - Additional Rules

1. Course selection

- Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1.
- Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.

2. Cross-Listed Courses

As a course can only be credited once, the following course replacement rules apply where a course is listed in more than one of your selected plans (minor, major or extended major).

- If the course is compulsory in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only. You must replace the compulsory course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second plan, at the same level or higher.
- If the course is compulsory in one plan only, it will be credited towards the plan in which it is compulsory. You must select the alternative course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second plan, at the same level or higher.
- If the course is an elective in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only.
