

This Program Planner is for Bachelor of Advanced Humanities (Honours) (BAdvHum(Hons)) students starting in 2024

Important Information

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a program and a subject as a course.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program (Core Courses, Extended Major or Major(s) or Program Electives or General Electives).

BAdvHum(Hons) Program Requirements

Your BAdvHum(Hons) comprises 64 units that you will complete over four years:

- 10 units for all BAdvHum(Hons) Core Courses; AND
- 38 units from the BAdvHum(Hons) Majors Options (see below for available options); AND
- 16 units for BAdvHum(Hons) Honours Courses

BAdvHum(Hons) Majors Options

You will complete one option from the list below. Please note that your choice will impact the number of elective courses you can complete in your program. Please also note that the Field of Study undertaken in your BAdvHum(Hons) Courses will correspond to the Major or Extended Major that you nominate to complete.

One Major Option

This option comprises 38 units for:

- One BAdvHum(Hons) Major (16 units); AND
- 8 units from BAdvHum(Hons) Program Elective Courses; AND
- 14 units from General Elective Courses

Two Majors Option

This option comprises 38 units for:

- Two BAdvHum(Hons) Majors (32 units); AND
- 6 units from General Elective Courses

Extended Major Option

This option comprises 38 units for:

- One BAdvHum(Hons) Extended Major (24 units); AND
- 14 units from General Elective Courses

BAdvHum(Hons) Program Elective Courses must be taken from the BAdvHum(Hons) course list only.

General Elective Courses are courses that can be from other areas in the BAdvHum(Hons) or from other UQ undergraduate programs that do not have restrictions.



Selecting Plans in mySI-net

A plan is a prescribed combination of courses within a program being either a Major (16 units) or Extended Major (24 units). In the BAdvHum(Hons) you will need to select either One BAdvHum(Hons) Major, Two BAdvHum(Hons) Majors or one BAdvHum(Hons) Extended Major.

Ensure the plans for your BAdvHum(Hons) are correctly listed in your <u>mySI-net</u> account. If you require assistance selecting your plans, follow these <u>instructions</u>.

How to use this Program Planner

This Program Planner assists you in drafting an enrolment plan to complete the requirements of a Bachelor of Advanced Humanities (Honours) as a full-time student over four years.

Read the program rules below, then add the courses that you are required to complete for option you have selected. You can view the list of courses for your BAdvHum(Hons) Core Courses, BAdvHum(Hons) Major(s) or your one BAdvHum(Hons) Extended Major in the <u>BAdvHum(Hons) Program Requirements</u> on the Programs and Courses website.

Don't forget to save your BAdvHum(Hons) Program Planner document to your files.

This program planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses in 2024. Students should note that course scheduling can change from year to year. You are advised to check the scheduling for the current year and contact the <u>Faculty</u> for advice if course scheduling has changed.

Bachelor of Advanced Humanities (Honours) – Additional Rules

1. Course selection

- Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1.
- Selected courses must include at least 24 units at level 3 or higher.

2. Progression through program

- A student may only enrol in BAdvHum(Hons) Honours Courses if they have completed 10 units for BAdvHum(Hons) Core Courses and 38 units for BAdvHum(Hons) Major Options
- A student may only enrol in a BAdvHum(Hons) field of study if they have gained a GPA of 5.5 or higher for a BAdvHum(Hons) major or a BAdvHum(Hons) extended major.
- A student who does not meet the requirements of rule 1.2 may only enrol in BAdvHum(Hons) Projects.
- To enrol in BAdvHum(Hons) Honours Courses following an interruption to studies, a student must consult with the Program Convenor to ensure that the student is prepared for enrolment.



3. Cross-Listed Courses

- As a course can only be credited once, the following course replacement rules apply where a course is listed in more than one of your selected plans (minor, major or extended major).
 - If the course is compulsory in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only. You
 must replace the compulsory course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second
 plan, at the same level or higher.
 - If the course is compulsory in one plan only, it will be credited towards the plan in which it is compulsory. You must select the alternative course in the second plan, with a course chosen from the second plan, at the same level or higher.
 - o If the course is an elective in more than one plan, it will be credited towards one plan only.

4. Class of honours

• Specific requirements apply to the awarding of honours in this program. The class of honours is calculated based on the grade point average of the grades obtained by a student in the first attempt at all 16 units from BAdvHum(Hons) Honours Courses.

5. Exit awards

• A student who withdraws from the program after completing the requirements for the Bachelor of Humanities program may apply and be awarded the Bachelor of Humanities.
