

## This Program Planner is for Master of Applied Linguistics (MAppLing) (2 year duration) students commencing Semester 1, 2024

### Important Information

- At UQ we refer to your degree as a **program** and a subject as a **course**.
- Most UQ courses are usually 2 units in value.
- If you are a **full-time student**, you will undertake 8 units (usually 4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards your program requirements (MAppLing Foundational, Core, Flexible Core or Field of Study/Program Elective Courses).

### MAppLing Requirements

Students in the MAppLing 2 year duration program complete 32 units comprising:

- 8 units for MAppLing Foundational Courses, and
- 8 units for all MAppLing Core Courses, and
- 2 to 6 units from MAppLing Flexible Core Courses, and
- 10 to 14 units for MAppLing Field of Study and MAppLing Program Elective Courses.

### How to use this Program Planner

This Program Planner assists you in drafting an enrolment plan to complete the Master of Applied Linguistics (2 year duration) in four semesters of full-time study.

MAppLing Foundational and Core Courses that must be taken in sequence are pre-filled. Read the program rules below, then add the MAppLing Flexible Core and Field of Study/Program Elective Courses that you choose to complete from your program requirements which can be viewed on the Programs and Courses [website](#).

#### Course Scheduling

This program planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses for 2024. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year. You are advised to check the scheduling for the current year and contact the [Faculty](#) for advice if course scheduling has changed.

#### Additional Rules

##### 1. Course selection

Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 7.

Selected courses must include at least 12 units at level 6 or higher.

Selected courses must include at most 8 units at level 3.

##### 2. Exit award

- **Award of the Graduate Diploma in Applied Linguistics**

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 16 units may apply and be awarded the Graduate Diploma in Applied Linguistics.

#### Flexible Core Course Option A: Dissertation -

- Foundational courses (8 units), Core Courses (8 units), Flexible Core Courses (6 units), Field of Study and Program Electives (10 units)

Students who choose the dissertation option complete a research dissertation (6 units of Flexible Core Courses) in their final semester of study. They complete a further 8 units in either a Field of Study (e.g. TESOL Studies) (8 units), plus program elective courses (2 units) OR 10 units of Program Elective Courses.
