

Program Planner – Master of Applied Linguistics (2 years duration) (MAppLing)

For students commencing in the Master of Applied Linguistics (2 years duration) in Semester 2 2023

MAppLing structure

The program consists of three components:

- 8 units Foundational Courses, and
- 8 units Core Courses, and

Either

- The Dissertation Option (16 units), or
- The Portfolio Option (16 units).

The Dissertation Option

Students who choose the dissertation option complete a research dissertation (6 units) in their final semester of study. They complete a further 10 units in either a Field of Study (e.g. TESOL Studies) (8 units), plus an elective course (2 units) OR 10 units of Program Elective Courses.

The Portfolio Option

Students who choose the portfolio option have more units available to take towards Program Elective Courses than students who choose the dissertation option. The portfolio option comprises SLAT7852 *Portfolio & Synthesis* (2 units) plus either a Field of Study (e.g. TESOL Studies) (8 units) and Program Elective Courses (6 units) OR SLAT7852 *Portfolio & Synthesis* plus 14 units of Program Elective Courses.

How to use this planner

This document assists you to draft an enrolment plan to complete the Master of Applied Linguistics (2 years duration).

Core courses that must be taken in sequence are pre-filled. Read the program rules below, then add the courses that are required to complete the option you choose. You will find your field of study and course requirements on the Programs and Courses website. Don't forget to save the document to your files.

Students are responsible for ensuring that they have complied with the rules relating to their program and have completed sufficient units to meet graduation requirements. Program planning advice is not binding on the Faculty of Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences or The University of Queensland.

Program Rules

1. Course selection

Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 7.

Selected courses must include at least 12 units at level 6 or higher.

Selected courses must include at most 8 units at level 3.

Selected courses must include at most 20 units at level 4.

2. Exit award

Award of the Graduate Diploma in Applied Linguistics

A student who withdraws from the program after completing 16 units may apply and be awarded the Graduate Diploma in Applied Linguistics.

Option A: Dissertation Option

Field of Study (8 units) + Program Elective Course (2 units)

Selected Field of Study:

Program Elective Courses (10 units) (no Field of Study)

Students who choose the dissertation option complete a research dissertation (6 units) in their final semester of study. They complete a further 10 units in either a Field of Study (e.g. TESOL Studies) (8 units), plus an elective course (2 units) OR 10 units of Program Elective Courses

It is strongly recommended to complete all Field of Studies courses BEFORE program electives.

Selected Field of Study:

Program Elective Courses (14 units) (no Field of Study)

The portfolio option comprises SLAT7852 Portfolio & Synthesis (2 units) plus either a Field of Study (e.g. TESOL Studies or Language Discourse Analysis) (8 units) and Program Elective Courses (6 units) OR 14 units of Program Elective Courses.

It is strongly recommended to complete all Field of Studies courses BEFORE program electives.
