Students are not permitted to undertake exchange in their final semester of study due to the requirement to complete compulsory level 3 courses and the risks associated with find a matching for these courses on exchange, which could result in having to undertake additional courses upon your return. If you are planning to undertake additional travel after your completion of studies and want to undertake exchange in your final semester, you must make a case to the Associate Dean (Academic) demonstrating that you have saved your elective courses for your final semester and that you understand the risks involved including that it could delay your graduation.
