PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 48 units for the program.

No more than 32 units may be from a single field.

At least 28 units must be at Advanced Level (Level 2 or Level 3 course eg. PSYC2XXX or PSYC3XXX) which must include at least 6 units at Level 3.

A minor consists of 8 units from one major list with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include a gateway course and a cornerstone course.

BACHELOR OF ARTS REQUIREMENTS:

- ❖ 48 units under the Bachelor of Arts course list including-
 - 28 units towards Psychology Extended Major
 - 8 units towards a Minor
 - 12 units of General Electives

INTERNATIONAL JOINT DEGREE PROGRAM – CREDIT ARRANGEMENT

- ❖ You will receive 16 units of credit on the basis of your studies at HELP University Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) including –
 - 6 units of compulsory gateway a towards Psychology Extended Major (PSYC1020, PSYC1030, PSYC1040)
 - 10 units of Introductory General Electives

As you have received 16 units of credit, you will have 32 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Arts program, comprising of:

- 8 units of compulsory cornerstone courses towards Psychology Extended Major (PSYC2010, PSYC2020, PSYC2030, PSYC2040, PSYC2050)
- 6 units of compulsory capstone courses towards Psychology Extended Major (PSYC3010, PSYC3020, PSYC3102)
- 2 units from either PSYC3042 or a level 3 PSYC course from one of the five study areas (Applied/Professional, Biological, Cognition, Developmental or Social) in Psychology Extended Major
- 4 units of level 3 PSYC course **from at least two of five areas** of study (Applied/Professional, Biological, Cognition, Developmental or Social) in Psychology Extended Major
- 8 units of a Minor including 2 units of compulsory gateway course, 2 units of compulsory cornerstone course, 4 units of other courses from the major course list which at least 2 units at an advanced Level (i. e. HIST2XXX)
- 2 units of General Electives at an **advanced** Level (i. e. HIST2XXX)

The following planner outlines what courses you will need to complete to meet the program requirements.

Please note that you are not required to submit this program plan for approval. This planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year.
