### Important Information

- This is an AQF Level 7 program.
- You must complete two majors in this program.
- You must complete an exchange semester in this program.
- Most UQ courses have a value of 2 units.
- If you are a full-time student, you will undertake 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards each plan (major / minor).

### Program Requirements

The BlntSt program consists of 48 units comprising –

- 6 units for all BlntSt Core Courses, and
  - 4 units from BlntSt Flexible Core Courses, and
  - 6 units from General Elective Courses, and
  - 16 units for one Major from BlntSt Language Majors, and
  - 16 units for one Major from BlntSt International Studies Majors.
- Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1.
- Selected courses must include at least 8 units at level 3.

Flexible Core Courses and any compulsory courses for the majors should be planned before elective courses in the chosen majors. It is recommended that general elective courses are completed on exchange. It is compulsory to complete an exchange semester for this program. It is recommended this semester is Year 3 Semester 1.

You may need to adjust the semesters of courses for your majors in the below planner depending on the major combination taken and their level of language skills. Students should consult <https://languages-cultures.uq.edu.au/study/whats-my-language-level> to determine their starting point and receive more detailed information about the courses to complete according to their language level.
