- If you are a full-time student, you will take 8 units (4 courses) each semester.
- A course can only count once towards each plan (major / minor).

#### **Program Requirements**

The BAdvHum(Hons) program consists of 64 units comprising -

- 10 units for all BAdvHum(Hons) Core Courses, and
- One of the following:
  - o 38 units for BAdvHum(Hons) One Major Option, or
  - o 38 units for BAdvHum(Hons) Two Major Option, or
  - o 38 units for BAdvHum(Hons) Extended Major Option , and
- 16 units for BAdvHum(Hons) Honours Courses
- Selected courses must include at most 24 units at level 1.
- Selected courses must include at least 24 units at level 3 or higher.
