

Bachelor of Arts Host University Recommendations

- For all majors, other universities listed as partners on the UQ Abroad website will be considered, in addition to those indicated below, providing they have sufficient courses in the chosen area, and where relevant course profiles can be provided.
- To gain maximum benefit from their exchange, language students should best consider studying in a country that speaks this language. However, their host institutions such as in Canada, UK and USA also offer language programs in conjunction with a range of other electives.
- In all cases, always also refer to the list provided on the [UQ Abroad website](#) for further information and take heed of additional advice specific to the host institution.

1. All students will have a greater selection of courses if they undertake exchange to Queens University in Semester 2 (Queen's University Fall semester).
2. Students will have a better choice of courses at the University of British Columbia (UBC) if they undertake exchange in Semester 2 (UBC Fall semester).
3. . Entry to courses in the humanities disciplines is highly competitive.
4. At the University of Nottingham an earlier deadline applies for applications for UQ semester 1 equivalent study and for students wishing to enrol the Department of Culture, Film and Media.
5. Only very few UQ students can be accepted at the Uni of Toronto in Canada, Humboldt Uni in Germany, and Boston College, the State Uni of New York Stony Brook, Rutgers University, Uni of Texas at Austin and Uni of Washington in the USA.
6. Exchange at the University of Connecticut is only available for non-specific electives as course profiles are not available in advance.
7. Exchange at the University of California is only available for non-specific electives as course profiles are not available in advance. Students may be assigned to any campus.

8. For students seeking exchange including Drama at Uni Toronto, DRM courses are very popular with few places available for exchange. You must be flexible and be able to include elective options in other disciplines as well to make up a full-time semester load.

9. Due to restricted course choices, exchange at the University of Sheffield is best for electives across a range of disciplines.

The semester timetable in the following institutions overlaps with that of UQ; students may return after the commencement of the following semester at UQ. In most instances, exchange in UQ semester 2 aligns better than going on exchange during UQ semester 1. You should consult with [UQ Abroad](#) to discuss options.

German	Albert-Ludwigs Uni Freiberg	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of semester dates. Strong German needed but good choice for such students. Most courses in German but also limited range of courses in English such as in economics, English literature, language & culture and politics. Course outlines not available prior. Students must have at least 6 units of free electives available.
	Leuphana Uni Lüneburg	Semester 2 exchange preferred as usually less overlap with the UQ timetable. German (but not A1 level) with electives. A 4 week language and orientation program is offered to all incoming exchange students (fee applies) that may contribute to credit for the semester. A limited range of courses are offered in English.
	HESSEN-Justus Liebig Uni Giessen	Semester 2 exchange preferred as usually less overlap with the UQ timetable. German as a foreign language courses and limited range of elective courses taught in English. Majority of courses must be from within a single faculty.
	Humboldt Uni	German language with other elective courses taught in English and German through the Berlin Perspectives program. Only very few UQ students can be accepted in each semester. Both semesters overlap with those at UQ.
	E. K Tübingen	Semester 2 exchange preferred as usually less overlap with the UQ timetable. The pre-semester intensive language courses at Tübingen are not included under the fee waiver. Only intermediate and advanced German taught. Limited range of courses in English for general electives.
Japanese	Hitosubashi Uni	Students must have completed 2 years university study prior to attending. Semester 1 timetable their Spring/Summer term, however, overlaps with semester 2 at UQ.
	International Christian Uni	Students have to take a full year on exchange.
	Keio Uni	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange. Students take a minimum of 7 courses (14 tani) across Japanese language and courses in English from the Keio International Program.
	Kobe Uni	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange. Japanese language and educational program on current Japan in English or English/Japanese focusing on current issues in Japan over a range of disciplines.
	KwanseiGakuin Uni	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange. Japanese and a range of electives from the Modern Japan Track.
	Kyoto University	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange.

	Osaka University	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange. Must be full-time at UQ before studying at Osaka University.
	Ritsumeikan Uni	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange. Japanese and elective courses in Intern. Rel., Asian Studies and Pols through the OSE program.
	Sophia Uni	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange. Japanese studied with elective courses in comparative culture, business and economics.
	Showa Women's Uni	Only suitable for more advanced Japanese language students. Students are required to enrol in 3 mandatory Japanese Language courses and 2 liberal arts courses (in English or Japanese). Both semesters may overlap with those at UQ.
	Uni of Tokyo	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with Semester 1 exchange. Japanese and electives from the Global Japan Studies program on politics, economics, culture and society of Japan and broader range of electives from USTEP program in Econ., Intern. Rel., Phil; Pols.
	Waseda Uni	Semester 2 exchange preferred due to overlap of timetables with semester 1 exchange. Japanese language (no electives) or electives from the Center for International Education incl. global studies and politics. Courses can be selected from only one School/Department.
