

HASS Leadership Program 2019

A student-lead initiative creating future leaders

The HASS Leadership Program is unique because it will challenge you to step beyond your academic disciplines and enhance your leadership abilities. The program is structured to give you a safe, experimental environment with support from mentors, team members, meetings, and workshops.

The HASS Leadership Program is an exciting new opportunity for dedicated students that:

- fosters leadership skills;
- enhances employability;
- facilitates connections with peers and faculty; and
- creates meaningful impact to the student community.

The program requires you to commit 20-25 hours of your time over the course of the semester. You will participate in seven activities that will enhance your leadership skills.

The activities will provide you with a comprehensive understanding of the theories of leadership as well as practical opportunities to develop your personal approach to leadership and teamwork.



The program has two phases:

Phase 1 (two activities)

Foundational Skills Development

- Introduction to theories of leadership;
- Guided leadership style self-identification

Phase 2 (five activities)

Practical Implementation and Experience

- Interactive workshops to guide you through the idea generation process;
- An introduction to pitching your idea and getting your project off the ground;
- Create an idea with your team to improve the HASS student experience;
- Make your idea a reality with the Student Experience grant
- Be mentored by experienced student partners and staff
