Important Information

- Students may use electives to complete an additional major in part B
- A student must complete at least 40 units of advanced level courses
- A student must not enrol in courses from Part C or D until gaining credit for all relevant courses in Part A, B and electives
- Due to staged introduction of courses it may take longer than anticipated for students with credit to complete program requirements
