

Transferring from the BA to another UQ degree

Information for students planning to transfer from Bachelor of Arts to

Bachelor of Business Management/Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Business Management.

The sample enrolment plan below is for students who are studying in the Bachelor of Arts in 2019 who hope to transfer into the Bachelor of Business Management, or add Business Management as a dual degree with Arts, in 2020. This plan has been approved by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences and the Faculty of Business, Economics and Law, and is provided as a guide only. The suggested courses are not compulsory, and many others are available.

Remember:

- To satisfy the Bachelor of Arts program rules, in their first year of study all full time BA students must complete their first 8 units of courses from Part A or B of the BA List (see <https://my.uq.edu.au/programs-courses/> to check the full Bachelor of Arts Program Requirements).
- You will need to satisfy subject prerequisites AND obtain grades that will derive the required OP/entry rank for the relevant program. These are often best achieved by enrolling in courses you enjoy and therefore you need to consider your choices carefully. You may wish to contact UQ Admissions to discuss how your entry rank will be calculated on the basis of your academic history.
- If you are intending to change programs you should familiarise yourself with all relevant rules and procedures. More information is available from:
