PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete a total of 48 units for the program.

At least 28 units must be at Advanced Level (Level 2 or Level 3 course eg. JOUR2XXX or JOUR3XXX)

BACHELOR OF JOURNALISM REQUIREMENTS:

- ❖ 48 units under the BJOUR course list including -
 - 24 units core courses from Part A; and
 - 8 units from Part B; and
 - 16 units of Electives, which may include up to two minors (16 units) from Part C and/or other courses.

INTERNATIONAL JOINT DEGREE PROGRAM – CREDIT ARRANGEMENT

- ❖ You will receive 24 units of credit on the basis of your studies at UI, including –
 - 10 units core courses from Part A (COMU1120, COMU1130, COMU1140, WRIT2000 and JOUR2221)
 - 4 units from Part B (COMU2170 and COMU1050)
 - 2 units from Part C towards PR Minor or Adv. Elective (COMU2180)
 - 8 units from Part C comprising of 6 units of Introductory Elective courses and a 2 unit Adv. Elective course.

As you have received 24 units of credit, you will have 24 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Journalism program, comprising of:

- 14 units of core courses from Part A (JOUR1112, JOUR1710, COMU2120, COMU2160, JOUR2100, JOUR3401 and JOUR3000)
- 4 units (2 courses) from Part B (COMU2140, JOUR2000, JOUR3122, JOUR3222 and/or JOUR3801)
- 6 units of elective courses comprising of a 2 unit Introductory level course and 4 units of Adv. level elective courses.

The following planner outlines what courses you will need to complete to meet the program requirements.

Please note that you are not required to submit this program plan for approval. This planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year.
