#### **PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

You must complete a total of 48 units for the program.

No more than 32 units may be from a single field.

At least 28 units must be at Advanced Level (Level 2 or Level 3 course e.g. PSYC2XXX or PSYC3XXX) which must include at least 6 units at Level 3.

A minor consists of 8 units from one major list with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level and must include a gateway course and a cornerstone course.

- ✤ 48 units under the Bachelor of Arts course list including-
  - 28 units towards Psychology Extended Major
  - 8 units towards Sociology Minor
  - 12 units of General Electives

#### INTERNATIONAL JOINT DEGREE PROGRAM – CREDIT ARRANGEMENT

- You will receive 24 units of credit on the basis of your studies at Chulalongkorn, Thailand including
  - 10 units of compulsory gateway and cornerstone courses towards Psychology Extended Major (NEUR1020, PSYC1030, PSYC1040, PSYC2030 and PSYC2040)
  - 2 units of compulsory gateway course towards Sociology Minor (SOCY1050)
  - 2 units of Introductory course towards Sociology Minor
  - 10 units of General Electives (6 units of Introductory Electives + 4 units of Advanced Electives)

# As you have received 24 units of credit, you will have 24 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Arts program, comprising of:

- 6 units of compulsory cornerstone courses towards Psychology Extended Major (PSYC2010, NEUR2020, PSYC2050)
- 6 units of compulsory capstone courses towards Psychology Extended Major (PSYC3010, PSYC3020, PSYC3102)
- 6 units of level 3 PSYC courses in the Psychology Extended Major
- 2 units of compulsory cornerstone course towards Sociology Minor (SOCY2345)
- 2 units of Advanced SOCY courses towards Sociology Minor
- 2 units of General Electives
