#### **PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

You must complete a total of 48 units for the program.

At least 28 units must be at Advanced Level (Level 2 or Level 3 course e.g. COMU2XXX) or COMU3XXX)

#### **BACHELOR OF COMMUNICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- 48 units under the BCommun course list including -
  - 20 units core courses from Part A; and
  - 12 units from one major (Public Relations) in Part B; and
  - 16 units of Electives

### **CREDIT ARRANGEMENT**

- You will receive 16 units of credit on the basis of your previous studies at Kolej-Poly-Tech MARA comprising:
  - 6 units of Core Courses from Part A (COMU1052, COMU1120, COMU1140)
  - 6 units of Introductory Electives
  - 4 units of Advanced Electives

As you have received 16 units of credit, you will have 32 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Communication program, comprising of:

- 14 units of core courses from Part A (COMU1130, WRIT1200, COMU2030, COMU2120, COMU2160, COMU2180, WRIT2000)
- 12 units from Public Relations Major in Part B (COMU1152, COMU3015, COMU3130, COMU3140, and 4 units from either COMU1050, COMU2170, COMU2311, COMU3222 or COMU3801)
- 4 units of Advanced Electives
- 2 units of Electives at any Level
