



## **CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

**In the University of Queensland's Advanced Humanities Orientation Camp  
Moreton Bay Research Station conducted at Stradbroke Island, Queensland  
Saturday 4 March to Sunday 5 March 2017  
for new students in the Bachelor of Advanced Humanities (Honours) program.**

Moreton Bay Research Station (from here on known as MBRS), University of Queensland (UQ) and other co-operating agencies and organisations act only in the capacity of agents for education program participants in the matters relating to transport, lodgings, ship charter, bus charter and other reservations and does not assume any liability whatsoever for any act or omission due to any act on the part of any person, whether principal, employee, agent or servant of MBRS, or of any place of lodging, bus tour operator, carrier, caterer or other party in any way concerned or interested in the program with MBRS irrespective of whether or not the act or omission to do any act causing personal injuries, death, loss, damage, accident or delay constitutes negligence on the part of any such person, principal, employee, agent or servant, or on the part of MBRS or of any place of lodging, bus tour operator, carrier, caterer or any other party in any way concerned or interested in the program with MBRS.

The orientation camp program will include meals, transport and accommodation to and from the starting and ending point of the program at The University of Queensland St Lucia campus, Brisbane.

**In the event that it is necessary to cancel the program, affected clients will be notified at least 10 days before the starting time of the program.**

Program participants are required to exert full co-operation and common sense and to follow the reasonable directions of the employees of MBRS, UQ and/or their agents during the program. Any program participant who undertakes any walking, running, climbing, abseiling, swimming, snorkelling, SCUBA diving or any similar such activity does so at their own risk, and by so doing absolves MBRS, UQ and their agents of all liability for any consequences of such activity. Notwithstanding, if any person participating in the program behaves in a manner, which, at the sole discretion of Orientation Camp Manager, is considered to be a threat to the safety or well-being of any person connected with the program, then that person will desist from the subject behaviour immediately upon being requested to do so by the Orientation Camp Manager. SCUBA diving is not permitted during the program. Alcoholic beverages and un-prescribed drugs are strictly prohibited.

MBRS provides no health or accident insurance for program participants. MBRS will not pay for any medical attention required by program participants.

The luggage and goods of program participants are carried at the participants' own risk and MBRS accepts no responsibility for damage including death, injury, delay or loss of any nature arising out of or incidental to the said program services or any services ancillary thereto, and the program participants' executors, administrators and dependents expressly renounce all claims against MBRS in respect thereof, whether the same be due or alleged to be due to negligence or misconduct of the part of MBRS or not.
