# UQ Promotional Games

## Terms and Conditions (Games of Skill)

1. By entering this promotion, you accept these Terms and Conditions.
2. Instructions and information on how to enter this promotion form part of these Terms and Conditions.
3. The promoter is The University of Queensland (ABN 63 942 912 684) of St Lucia, Queensland, 4072 (“**Promoter**”).

## Eligible entrants

4. To be eligible to enter this promotion, you must:
  - (a) Be over the age of 18 years;
  - (b) Be enrolled in one of the The University of Queensland Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences’ programs of study and associated dual programs;
  - (c) Enter the competition as an individual or as part of a team of no more than four students;
  - (d) Have volunteered your time to complete the project and have not received any remuneration (e.g. paid employment) or other monetary compensation (e.g. Student-Staff Partnership grant); and
  - (e) Have demonstrated to the Promoter’s reasonable satisfaction that all entrants have participated in all components of the Leadership Intensive OR received an exception from the Promoter.

## How to enter

5. Entry will be open from 12:00AM AEST on 26/03/2021 and close at 23:59PM AEST on 30/05/2021. Entries received outside of the Entry Period will not be accepted.
6. To enter, a nominated team member must, during the entry period:
  - (a) Visit [studenthub.uq.edu.au](http://studenthub.uq.edu.au) and fully complete the online entry form, including your full name, address, email address, telephone number; and
  - (b) Submit responses which respond to the key selection criteria:
    - i. **Project overview** – The extent to which you clearly and succinctly articulate the activities and outcomes of the project.
    - ii. **Innovation** – The extent to which your project improved, or contributed to improving, the first year and/or second year student experience within HASS in Semester 1, 2021.
    - iii. **Sustainability** - The extent to which your project is able to be continued outside of the competition.
    - iv. **Community** – The extent to which your project encouraged connections, targeted under-represented groups or promoted broad inclusivity.
  - (c) Optional: Upload up to three (3) additional items as evidence of your projects success/ undertakings. These should be items that would assist a judging panel in understanding your project and the impact it has had. These items can include: video testimonials, surveys etc. Please ensure any written support is less than 250 words per document, and any verbal/ video support is less than one (1) minute in length. If you have material that you wish to submit that falls outside of the above categories, please contact [studentfutures@hass.uq.edu.au](mailto:studentfutures@hass.uq.edu.au).

7. You will receive one entry into the promotion by performing the activities listed in clause 6. You may enter the promotion more than once if you can demonstrate to the judges' satisfaction that this is a separate and unique project.
8. All entries become the property of the Promoter.

## Judging

9. This promotion is a game of skill. Chance plays no part in determining the winners.
10. All valid entries will be judged individually on their merits. The entries will be judged on how their selection criteria responses address each of the following criteria:

### Criteria

- a) **Project overview** – The extent to which you clearly and succinctly articulate the activities and outcomes of the project.
  - b) **Innovation** – The extent to which your project improved, or contributed to improving, the first year and/or second year student experience within HASS in Semester 1 2021.
  - c) **Sustainability** - The extent to which your project is able to be continued outside of the competition.
  - d) **Community** – The extent to which your project encouraged connections, targeted under-represented groups or promoted broad inclusivity.
11. Judging will take place in two phases. In the first phase, the Student Futures team will act as judges and create a shortlist of entries which in their view best meets the criteria. In the second phase, judges selected by the promoter will select up to three winners (first, second and third) from the shortlisted entries of the entry which best meets the criteria, and which meet a minimum standard required to justify winning a prize. The Promoter may not award all three prizes if it considers that there is an insufficient number which meets a minimum standard required to justify winning a prize.
  12. Judging of the first phase will take place after the competition closes, and judging of the second phase will take place at 10:00amAEST on 03/06/21 at St Lucia Campus. Entries will be judged by a panel of judges from UQ.
  13. The Promoter may decline to accept any entry which, in its reasonable opinion, does not comply with these Terms and Conditions.
  14. The Promoter's decision in relation to any aspect of the promotion is final and the Promoter will not enter into any correspondence regarding the result of the promotion.

## Prize and notification of winners

15. The judges will award up to three prizes (first, second and third). There is a total prize pool of up to \$5000, with \$2500 for first prize, \$1500 for second prize and \$1000 for third prize. If an individual wins a prize they receive the full amount available for that prize. If a team (of up to four members) receives a prize, each team member will receive an equal share of the full amount available for that prize. All winners will receive a group career mentorship session, including advice on how to continue their project in the future.
16. The winners will be contacted by email using the email address provided on their entry form on or by 07/06/21. The results will be published at <https://hass.uq.edu.au/hass-leadership-info> on 04/06/2021 with commendations of each project to be placed on the website by 11/06/2021.

17. To claim the prize, the winners must provide appropriate banking information to the Promoter. The prize must be claimed by 20/06/21 being a reasonable period after the winner is contacted.
18. If the Promoter is unable to contact the winner by 13/06/21 being a reasonable period after the judging to enable the winner to be found, that winner will forfeit the prize and the prize may be awarded to the next best entry (as determined by the judges). The new winner will be contacted by email using the email address provided on their entry form on or by 14/06/21.
19. The prize will be delivered to the winner by bank transfer within 60 days after the prize being claimed.
20. If any prize becomes unavailable for any reason, the Promoter may substitute a prize of equal or greater value. The Promoter reserves the right to not distribute the total prize pool if it considers that there is an insufficient number which meets a minimum standard required to justify winning a prize.
21. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any tax implications that may arise for any prize.

### Intellectual property

22. You confirm and promise that your entry is original and does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party. You agree that the Promoter has an unrestricted, irrevocable, transferable, right and licence to use and modify your entry including for promotional purposes without the payment of any further fee or compensation or further reference to you, and that the Promoter can authorise other people to do any of these things. If requested by the Promoter, you agree to sign any further documentation required by the Promoter to give effect to this arrangement. To the extent permitted by law, you unconditionally and irrevocably consent to the Promoter modifying your entry as described in this clause, agree that the Promoter is not required to attribute you as author of the entry, and consent to any other act or omission that would otherwise infringe any moral rights in your entry.

### Withdrawal from promotion

23. You may withdraw from the promotion at any time before notification of the winners by notifying the Promoter on 3443 2497 or by emailing [studentfutures@hass.uq.edu.au](mailto:studentfutures@hass.uq.edu.au). If you withdraw from the promotion, the Promoter will remove your entry and will not use your details or entry for media or promotional purposes. If you withdraw from the promotion, you will no longer be eligible to win a prize.

### Miscellaneous

24. Entries which, in the opinion of the Promoter, are incomplete, incorrect or incomprehensible, contain defamatory or offensive content or infringe intellectual property rights are not eligible to win and may be removed from the promotion and the relevant entrant will be disqualified.
25. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, disqualify you if, in the opinion of the Promoter, you breach these Terms and Conditions, engage in dishonest or unethical conduct in relation to the promotion, manipulate, tamper or interfere with the conduct of the promotion, do not comply with the entry process, or conspire with others to gain an unfair advantage. The Promoter may investigate the matter if it suspects you of having engaged in such breach or conduct.
26. The Promoter may request information from you relevant to entry or participation in the promotion, such as proof of residency or age. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, disqualify you if you provide insufficient information, false information or fail to provide information.
27. The Promoter is not responsible for any late, lost or misdirected entries.

28. The Promoter is not responsible for any delays, problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer systems, computer equipment or software, technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet or at any website, or any combination thereof, including any injury or damage to your or any other person's computer related to or resulting from entering this promotion. If such problems arise, then the Promoter may modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the promotion.
29. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for any loss, damage or injury whatsoever (including, but not limited to, indirect or consequential loss) resulting from this promotion, including the taking of prizes.
30. If, for any reason, this promotion is not capable of running as planned, including war, terrorism, state of emergency or disaster, infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion.
31. All costs associated with entering the promotion are your responsibility.
32. You understand and agree that the Promoter may collect personal information from you when you enter the promotion, and use it for the purpose of running the promotion (which may include disclosure to third parties for the purpose of processing and conducting the promotion), for promotional purposes surrounding this promotion, as well as other purposes, as set out in the Promoter's Privacy Policy (located at <https://ppl.app.uq.edu.au/content/1.60.02-privacy-management>).
