Here are some resources which the HASS Student Futures Team can provide to you so that you can implement your project. Volunteers

We have a large pool of 160+ volunteers that we can call on to assist you in a variety of capacities. Volunteers could be used for events, social media creation, data collection etc. The scope of your volunteer roles should be defined in liaison with the Student Futures Team to ensure the activities performed are consistent with the definition of volunteering. Set up a meeting with us if this is a resource you would like to engage!

Social media/ marketing assistance

The HASS Student Futures team controls the uqhasslife Instagram page, UQ Humanities and Social Sciences LinkedIn, and shares joint control over the UQ Humanities and Social Sciences Facebook page. What this means is that we can support you in marketing your project and driving your engagement. Let us know what you would like to advertise and when, and we can work with you on making this happen.

Connecting with appropriate staff members who may wish to be stakeholders in your project

We understand that one of the biggest challenges with implementing a project is not knowing where to start, or not knowing who to approach! Luckily, our team can help you navigate the complex structures of UQ and can link you with the correct staff members to assist you in your projects.
