## **Program Guidelines**

- You must complete a total of 48 units for the program. •
- No more than 32 units with the same discipline descriptor.eg. POLS or ENGL
- The first 8 units you study must be from the BA course list. •
- No more than 24 units of introductory level 1 courses. •
- A minor consists of 8 units from one minor list with a maximum of 4 units at introductory level 1 courses.
- A course can only count towards one major or minor. •

## **Bachelor of Arts Requirements:**

- 48 units under the Bachelor of Arts (BA) course list comprising -
  - two majors (16 units per major); or
  - both -0
    - an extended major (24 units), and
    - a minor (8 units); and .
  - 16 units of general elective courses from the BA course list or other undergraduate course list(s). 0

### Credit Arrangement

You will receive 16 units of elective credit on the basis of your previous studies at University of Indonesia including –

- 6 units of compulsory gateway and 2 units of compulsory cornerstone courses towards Psychology Extended Major (NEUR1020, PSYC1030, PSYC1040, PSYC2030)
- 8 units of Introductory General Electives

### As you have received 16 units of credit, you will have 32 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Arts program, comprising of:

- 8 units of compulsory level 2 courses towards Psychology Extended Major (NEUR2020, PSYC2010, PSYC2040, PSYC2050)
- 6 units of compulsory level 3 courses towards Psychology Extended Major (PSYC3010, PSYC3020, PSYC3102)
- 2 units of level 3 elective PSYC courses from the Psychology Extended Major course list (NEUR3192/NEUR3272/NEUR3302/PSYC3032/PSYC3052/PSYC3062/PSYC3082/PSYC3122/PSYC3122/PSY C3132/PSYC3202/PSYC3262/PSYC3282/PSYC3312.
- 8 units towards a Minor including 8 units of courses from a minor course list with at least 4 units at an advanced Level 2/3 (i.e. HIST2XXX)
- 8 units of General Electives of which at least 2 units at an advanced Level (i.e. SPAN2XXX)
