Credit Arrangement

You will receive 24 units of elective credit on the basis of your previous studies, including -

- 10 units core courses from Part A (COMU1052, COMU1120, COMU1130, COMU1140 and WRIT1200)
- 2 units of COMU1152 towards Public Relations Major
- 2 units of JOUR1112 towards ELECTIVES
- 2 units of Introductory ELECTIVES
- 8 units of Advanced ELECTIVES

As you have received 24 units of credit, you will have 24 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Communication program, comprising of:

- 6 units of core courses from Part A (COMU2030, COMU2160, COMU3150) and
- 14 units from Public Relations Major (COMU2180, COMU3015, COMU3130, COMU3140 and 6 units from COMU1050, COMU2120, COMU2170, COMU2311, COMU3222 and COMU3801) and
- 4 units of ELECTIVES
