    - Two minors (8 units for each minor), or both;
    - 8 units for a minor, and 8 units of general elective courses from the BCommun course list or other undergraduate course list(s): or
    - General elective courses from the BCommun course list or other undergraduate course list(s).

### **Credit Arrangement**

You will receive 16 units of credit on the basis of your previous studies, comprised of

- 6 units comprising core courses for COMU1052, COMU1120 and COMU1140;
- 2 units for MSTU1001 towards the Digital Media major; and
- 8 units of introductory level electives

As you have received 16 units of credit, you will have 32 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Communication program, comprising of:

- 10 units for Core Courses (COMU1130, WRIT1200, COMU2030, COMU2160, COMU3150); and
- 14 units for the Digital Media Major; including
  - o 10 units for COMU2120, COMU2140, COMU3100, COMU3110, COMU3120;
  - and 4 units from COMU1050, COMU2150, COMU2311, COMU3222, COMU3801 or MSTU2008
  - 8 units for a minor, or 8 units of general elective courses from the BCommun course list or other undergraduate course list(s). This must include at least 6 units at level 2 or 3.
