Program Guidelines

You must complete a total of 48 units for the program.

A maximum of 24 units of courses at Level 1 (eg. COMU1XXX).

Bachelor of Journalism Requirements:

- 48 units under the Bachelor of Journalism (BJ) course list including
 - 24 units for Core Courses; and
 - 8 units from Flexible Core Courses; and
 - 16 units for—
 - (i) both —
 - (A) 8 units for a minor; and
 - (B) 8 units of general elective courses from the BJ course list or other approved course list(s); or
 - (ii) two minors; or
 - (iii) general elective courses from the BJ course list or other approved course list(s).

Credit Arrangement

You will receive 24 units of credit on the basis of your previous studies comprising:

- 12 units for Core for COMU1120, COMU1130, COMU1140, COMU2160, JOUR2221 and WRIT2000
- 4 units for flexible core course for COMU1050 and COMU2170 and
- 8 units for electives

As you have received 24 units of credit, you will have 24 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Journalism program, comprising of:

- 12 units for Core Courses (JOUR1112, JOUR1710, COMU2120, JOUR3401, JOUR3100 and JOUR3000); and
- 4 units for Flexible Core Courses (2 units from COMU2140 or JOUR2000 and 2 units from JOUR3122, JOUR3222 or JOUR3801)
- 8 units for electives, which may include a minor (8 units). Credit towards COMU2180 if the PR Minor is taken.

The following planner outlines what courses you will need to complete to meet the program requirements.

Please note that you are not required to submit this program plan for approval. This planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year.
