Program Guidelines

You must complete a total of 48 units for the program.

At least 24 units must be at Advanced Level (Level 2 or Level 3 course eg. COMU2XXX or COMU3XXX)

Bachelor of Journalism Requirements:

- 48 units under the Bachelor of Journalism (BJourn) course list including
 - 24 units core courses; and
 - 8 units flexible core courses; and
 - 16 units of Electives

Credit Arrangement

You will receive 16 units of elective credit on the basis of your previous studies

As you have received 16 units of credit, you will have 32 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Journalism program, comprising of:

- 24 units of core courses from Part A (COMU1120, COMU1130, COMU1140, JOUR1112, JOUR1710, COMU2120, COMU2160, JOUR2100, JOUR2221, WRIT2000, JOUR3401, JOUR3000)
- 8 units flexible core courses (COMU1050, COMU2140, COMU2170, JOUR2000, JOUR3122, JOUR3222, JOUR3801)

The following planner outlines what courses you will need to complete to meet the program requirements.

Please note that you are not required to submit this program plan for approval. This planner is intended as a guide only and is based on current scheduling of courses. Students should note that scheduling can change from year to year.
