

## Transferring from the BA to another UQ degree

Information for students planning to transfer from Bachelor of Arts to

## **Bachelor of Psychological Science (Honours)**

The sample enrolment plan below is for students who are studying in the Bachelor of Arts in 2019 who hope to transfer into the Bachelor of Psychological Science (Honours) in 2020. This plan has been approved by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences and the Faculty of Health and Behavioural Sciences and is provided as a guide only. This information is based on the current structure of the BPsySc (Hons) program. Should the structure change in the future, students will be required to comply with the requirements of the program for the year they enter the BPsySc (Hons). The suggested courses are not compulsory, and many others are available.

## **Remember:**

- To satisfy the Bachelor of Arts program rules, in their first year of study all full time BA students must complete their first 8 units of courses from Part A or B of the BA List (see <a href="https://my.uq.edu.au/programs-courses/">https://my.uq.edu.au/programs-courses/</a> to check the full Bachelor of Arts Program Requirements).
- Students will need to satisfy subject prerequisites AND obtain grades that will derive the required OP/entry rank
  for the *relevant program*. These are often best achieved by enrolling in courses they enjoy and therefore should
  consider their choices carefully. Students may wish to contact UQ Admissions to discuss how their entry rank
  will be calculated on the basis of their academic history.
- Students intending to change programs in 2021 should familiarise themselves with all relevant rules and procedures. More information is available from:
