

Transferring from the BA to another UQ degree

Information for students planning to transfer from Bachelor of Arts to

Bachelor of Business Management/Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Business Management

The sample enrolment plans below are for students who are studying in the Bachelor of Arts in 2022 who hope to transfer into the Bachelor of Business Management, or add Business Management as a dual degree with Arts, mid-year, 2022 or hope to transfer into the Bachelor of Economics or Bachelor of Economics/Bachelor of Arts in 2023. These plans have been approved by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences and the Faculty of Business, Economics and Law, and are provided as a guide only. The suggested courses are not compulsory, and many others are available.

Remember:

- To satisfy the Bachelor of Arts program rules, in their first year of study **all BA students must complete their first 8 units of courses the BA course list** with the exception of General Elective Courses (see <https://future-students.uq.edu.au/study/programs/bachelor-arts-2000> to check the full Bachelor of Arts Program Requirements).
- Students will need to satisfy subject prerequisites AND obtain grades that will derive the required OP/entry rank for the *relevant program*. These are often best achieved by enrolling in courses they enjoy and therefore should consider their choices carefully. Students may wish to contact UQ Admissions to discuss how their entry rank will be calculated on the basis of their academic history.
- Students intending to change programs mid-year in 2022 or 2023 should familiarise themselves with all relevant rules and procedures. More information is available from:

You can receive a maximum of 2 units credit for level 1 electives in the dual BBusMan/BA program.
