Office 365 for personal use

Office 365 is a package of software applications offered by Microsoft available to UQ staff and students free-of-charge on both their UQ and personal computers.

Office 365 includes:

- . Microsoft Office 365 applications (e.g. Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook)
- · collaboration tools (e.g. Teams and Planner)
- · cloud services (e.g. OneDrive cloud storage).



The instructions on this page are for personal computers. If you need Office 365 installed on a UQ computer, submit an IT request.

If you're using Office 365 to access your email on a personal device, normal UQ policies apply, including 6.20.06 Acceptable Use of UQ ICT Resources.

Using Office 365

You can use Office 365 on up to 5 devices, including a UQ computer if you've been assigned one.

Office 365 is supported on:

- . PCs and Windows tablets running Windows 7 or higher
- . Macs with Mac OS X 10.6 or higher
- · iPads running iOS 7.0 or higher.

You can also access Office mobile applications on iPhone and Android devices.

All students are eligible for a free version of Office365 for as long as they study at UQ

Once you graduate or finish your studies you will have to pay to continue to use it

Black and White (default) and Colour is available







Learn.UQ (Blackboard) is the eLearning software UQ uses for course delivery.

Learn.UQ (Blackboard) provides:

- A user profile
- Course notes
- Lecture Recordings (Echo360)
- Collaborative tools
- Turnitin (for electronic assignment submission)

Note: Your enrolment may take up to 48 hours to process through the system. During this time you will be unable to see your Learn.UQ (Blackboard) courses or access the Internet.






