Program Guidelines

You must complete a total of 48 units for the program.

A maximum of 24 units of courses at Level 1 (eg. COMU1XXX).

Bachelor of Communication Requirements:

- 48 units under the Bachelor of Communication (BCommun) course list including
 - o 16 units for Core Courses; and
 - o 16 units from one Major (Digital Media or Public Relations) in the BCommun Plans; and
 - 16 units of Electives

Please ensure the Major (plan) for your program is correctly listed in <u>mySI-net</u>. If you require assistance selecting your Major, follow these <u>instructions</u>.

Credit Arrangement

You will receive 16 units of elective credit on the basis of your previous studies

As you have received 16 units of credit, you will have 32 units remaining to complete the Bachelor of Communication program, comprising of:

- 16 units for Core Courses (COMU1052, COMU1120, COMU1130, COMU1140, WRIT1200, COMU2030, COMU2160, COMU3150); and
- 16 units for one Major:
 - Digital Media Major (10 units from COMU2120, COMU2140, COMU3100, COMU3110, COMU3120, and 6 units from COMU1050, COMU2150, COMU2311, COMU3222, COMU3801, MSTU1001 or MSTU2008)
 - Public Relations Major (10 units from COMU1152, COMU2180, COMU3015, COMU3130, COMU3140 and 6 units from COMU1050, COMU2120, COMU2170, COMU2311, COMU3222 or COMU3801)
