Course enrolment & tutorial sign-on

- Log into <u>Starting at UQ</u>. Go to mySI-net to enrol in courses.

UQ Program Planner

The Program Planner is a tool that allows you to plan courses for your program and ensure that the plan meets the program's completion rules and chosen structure.





Frequently asked questions:

- Course profiles & Blackboard: What is Blackboard and ECP? How do I access my lecture recordings and modules?
- *Timetabling:* What do I do if I have a timetable clash?
- **Assessment:** Is it compulsory to attend a lecture/tutorial and will I be graded on attendance?
- **Textbooks**: Where do I find information about required readings/textbooks? Should I wait until Week 1 to buy reading materials?

Semester-based Exchange

Study overseas with one of 120+ distinguished UQ partner universities around the world. Immerse yourself in another culture, experience new education systems, and gain international connections.

When?	During UQ semesters	Credit? 6-8 UQ units + COMU 3060/3065
How Long?	1 or 2 semesters	Application Deadlines
Mode?	Exchange – stay enrolled at UQ	31 May for exchange in Semester 1 the following year
Tuition	Paid to UQ	31 October for exchange in Semester 2 the following year







Am I eligible for Exchange?

Eligibility Criteria: Part 1*



Enrolled at UQ & achieve a min GPA of 4.5 in the semester of application



Meet requirements set by host university (GPA, units completed, etc)



Have a min cumulative GPA of 4.5



Complete a min # of units in current program

Undergraduate = 12 units



International students cannot attend a university in their country of citizenship



Meet Part 2 Eligibility** including receiving an approved study plan

*Part 1 eligibility criteria will be assessed after the application deadline and the release of grades. **Part 2 eligibility criteria (more information online) will be assessed progressively in the months that follow the application deadline.
