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

Bachelor of Music (Honours) structure

The compulsory core courses are completed over the first three years of your studies.

You complete a research methods course in Year 3 Semester 1 and your year-long thesis or project course in Year 4.

You can also take electives in the single degree, or courses in your other degree if you're a dual degree student.

The core course sequence includes compulsory courses in

- Performance Studies
- Musicianship
- Music History and Musicology

Musicianship Self-Testing

The School offers two first-year Musicianship courses:

- MUSC1060 Introduction to Musicianship Semester One, optional for all students
- MUSC1600 Musicianship 1 Semester Two, compulsory for BMus(Hons) and BA Music students




