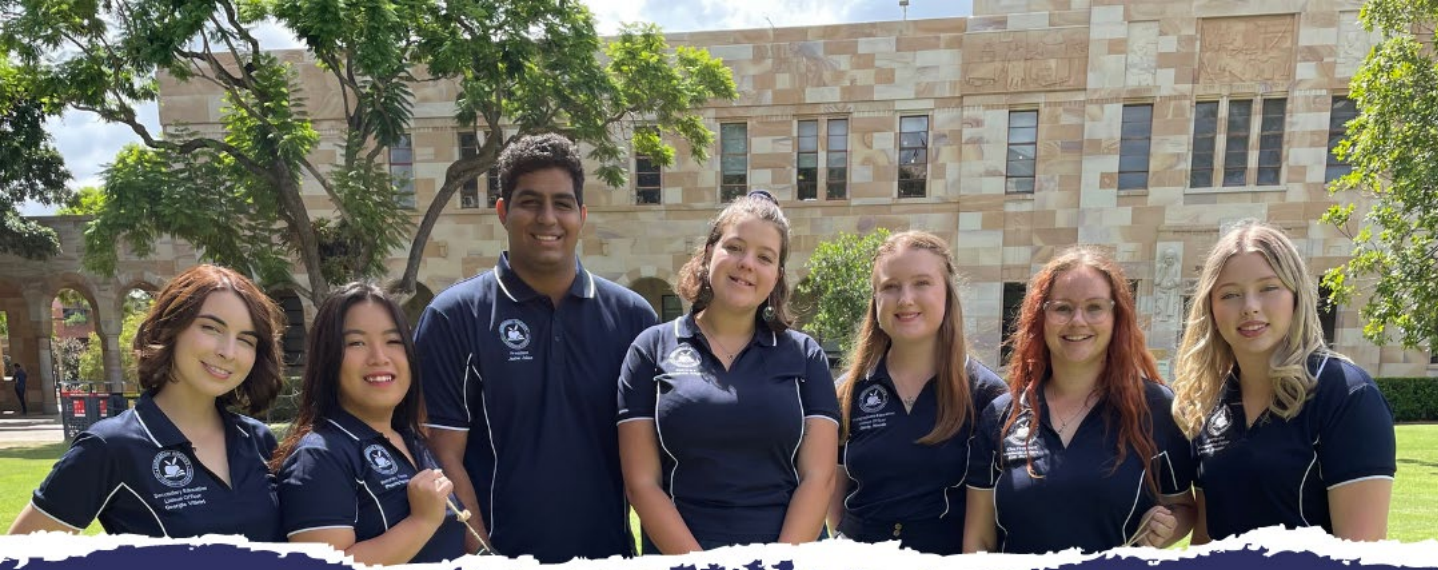



Project courses are not compulsory.

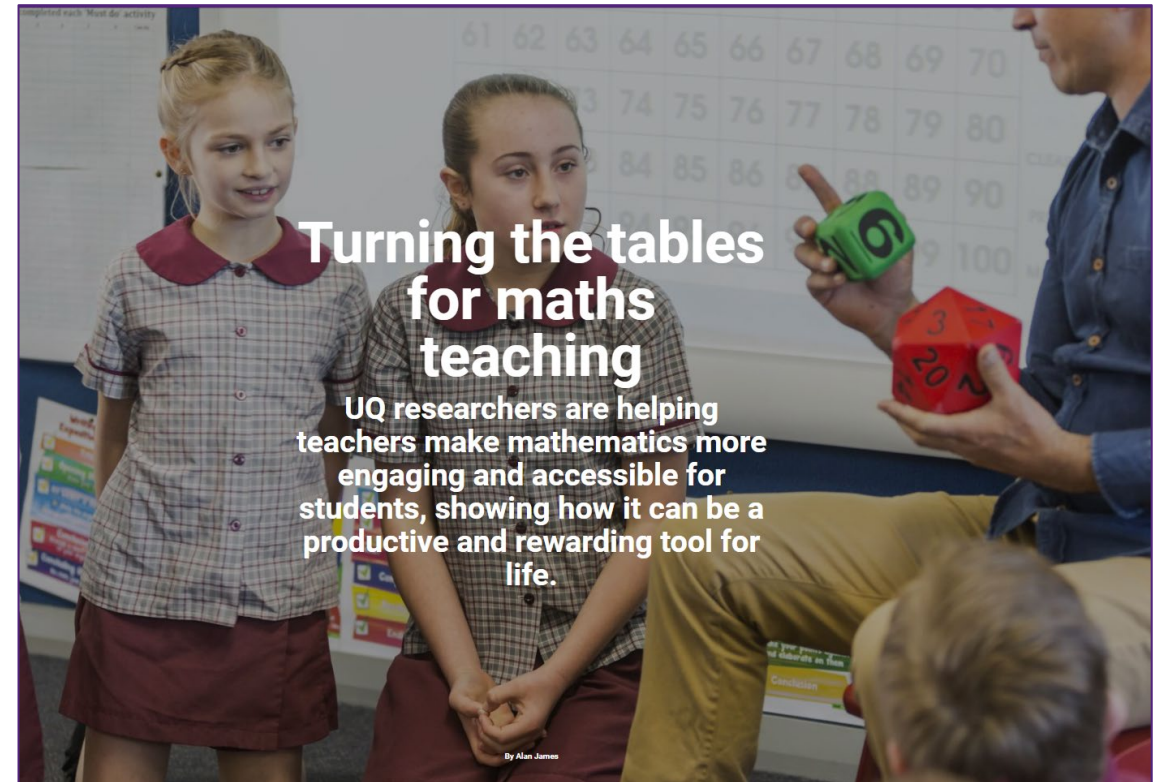

The Program Planner is a tool that allows you to plan courses for your program and ensure that the plan meets the program's completion rules and chosen structure.





Appropriate Grade Point Average (5.65 PhD, 5.0 MPhil on a 7-point scale) **and** Inclusion of relevant research component in your coursework program.
