## TIPS to HELP you SUCCEED

- Mix with other students as much as possible.
   The best learning is social learning we learn with each other
- 2. Writing in English is much more difficult than speaking English, so read books written in English as much as possible to get used to written English
- 3. Enrol in the writing course (WRIT6001) **this** semester as a foundation for all of your program
- 4. Have all assignments and projects professionally proof-read by someone for whom English is their <u>first</u> language. Student Services provides some assistance with English as well




